In addition to this we also regularly put on other sensory and memory focussed activities for the residents. These activities help our residents to practice simple tasks to help improve their cognitive function and recall skills, whilst having fun.





Recently some of the residents took part in aqua painting, which is a sensory painting activity using only water to create pictures. It is mess free and helps to increase levels of concentration in a fun and creative format.





We always enjoy a visit from our friends at The Pony Pals, these pets as therapy sessions are a favourite activity with our residents and always bring big smiles to their faces.







In June we put on a special celebration for the residents in honour of the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. We were thrilled to welcome family and friends to join us for our celebration in the garden, where we enjoyed live music, delicious food and some fun games.

The afternoon was filled with laughter and fun, it was lovely to see everyone coming together to celebrate this special occasion.





We have been making use of the Beritaz minibus to arrange fun day trips for the residents, we have visited local attractions such as Frensham Great Pond & Common, and trips to the beach to enjoy the views.
